Please:

Check Pattern Measurements for Distance and Seams before cutting fabric

**Use:** Red - Blue - White fabric (subtle prints ok)

**Cut:** **A** 2 RED      **B** 4 RED      **C** 4 RED  
           2 BLUE      4 BLUE      4 BLUE  
           4 WHITE                    8 WHITE

Directions: (all seams are 1/4")

**Step 1** Position all pieces as shown.

**Step 2** Sew **C** Triangle sections together to make 8 sets:

2 sets red white  + 2 sets white red 

2 sets blue white  + 2 sets white blue 

Press seams, return to layout position

**Step 3** Sew 8 **C** Triangle sets to **B** triangles as shown, →

Press, return to layout position



**Step 4** Chain-Sew column 2 blocks to column 1 blocks, Sew column 4 to column 3.

Chain 2 chain sets together by sewing column 3 to column 2. Press seams.

Lay chained unit flat to make sure blocks are in order and turned correctly

**Step 5** Fold rows right sides together, sew Row 1 to row 2, row 2 to 3 and row 3 to 4.

Press. Bring completed block to CCQ Mtg. July 10, 2007.
