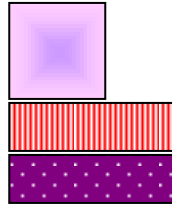
Check Pattern Measurements for Distance and Seams before cutting fabric

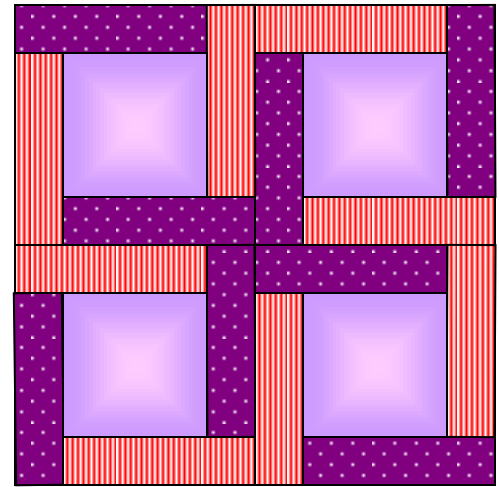
Use: Purple, Red, and a Red Hat theme or Pink print fabric

Cut: **A** – 4 ea Red Hat or pink print



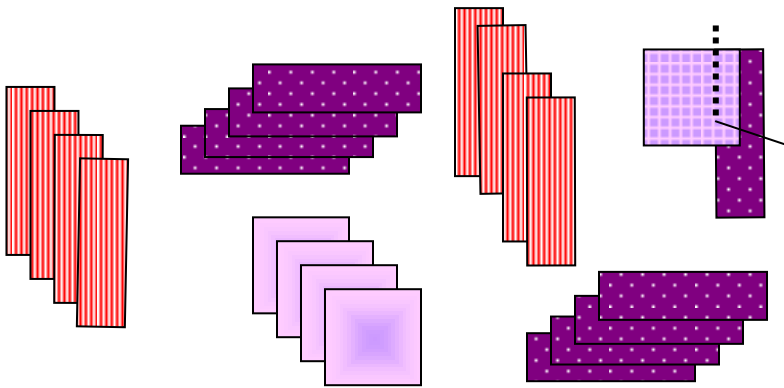
B – 8 ea Purple and Red

RED
PURPLE



DIRECTIONS: (all seams are 1/4") Chain sew 4 patches by steps

- Step 1** Stack pieces to form 4 blocks
- Step 2** Starting with **Purple** strip face up and Center block face down, Sew partial seam stopping 1 inch before end of block Repeat 3 times. Clip sections apart and finger press open.
- Step 3** Sew **Red** strip across end of block & purple strip joined in step 2. Repeat 3 times, Clip apart & finger press open.
- Step 4** Sew second **Purple** strip across block & red strip just joined. Repeat 3 times, Clip apart & finger press open.
- Step 5** Sew second **Red** strip across block & purple strip just joined. Repeat 3 times, Clip apart & finger press open.
- Step 6** Finish beginning seam to close block. Press flat, trim all threads
- Step 7** Position blocks so that the center joining strips are all **Purple**.
- Step 8** Join blocks together and press.

2" X 5" Rectangle

Cut: 8 Red
8 Purple
