# Kentucky Chain

12" Block

**Use Fabrics:** • Dark Brown • Cream • Animal (skin print fabric)

**CUT PATTERN PIECES AS FOLLOWS:**

<b>A</b> 	<b>B</b> 	<b>C</b> 
<b>2 Dark Brown</b> <b>2 Cream (muslin)</b>	<b>4 Dark Brown</b> <b>4 Cream (muslin)</b>	<b>16 Animal Print</b>

**Directions:** NOTE: All seam allowances are 1/4"

**Step 1** Position all pieces as shown.

**Step 2** Sew **C** Triangles to **B** points to make 'Point Sets'

**4 sets =**  **4 sets =** 

*print / Brown / print*      *print / Cream / print*

Press seams away from center,  
Return sections to layout position

**Step 3**

1. Sew cream point sets to either side of **Brown** Center Strips. Make 2 units.
2. Sew brown point sets to either side of **Cream** Center Strips. Make 2 units.

Press seams toward center.

**Step 4**

Position blocks with **Brown** points joining at center. **Cream** strips & points form 'on point' square

**Step 5**


Sew Blocks together.  
Press seams
