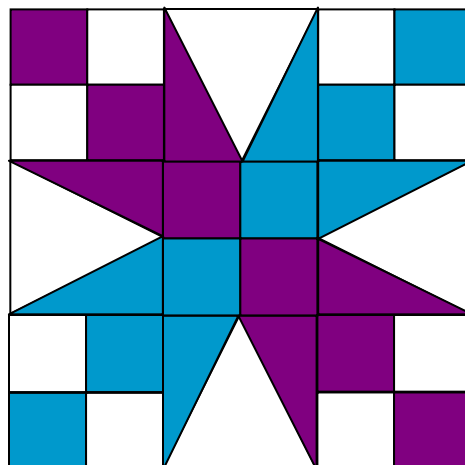

Patterns: **A** **B** **C** (fabric provided)
 4 Background 2 Purple Left 8 Background
 2 Purple Right 6 Purple
 2 Aqua Left 6 Aqua
 2 Aqua Right

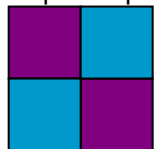


Directions: Note: All seam allowances are 1/4"

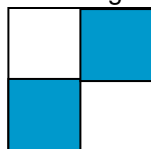
Step 1 Position all pieces as shown.

Step 2 Sew **C** blocks into 4 patches:

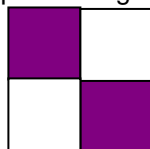
1 4-patch
Purple / aqua



2 4-patches
aqua / background

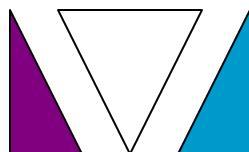


2 4-patches
purple / background



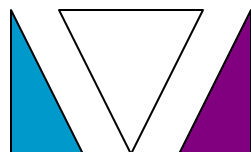
Step 3 Sew **Triangle Blocks A** with **Background B** Left & Right pieces:

2 sets =



purple / background / aqua

2 sets =

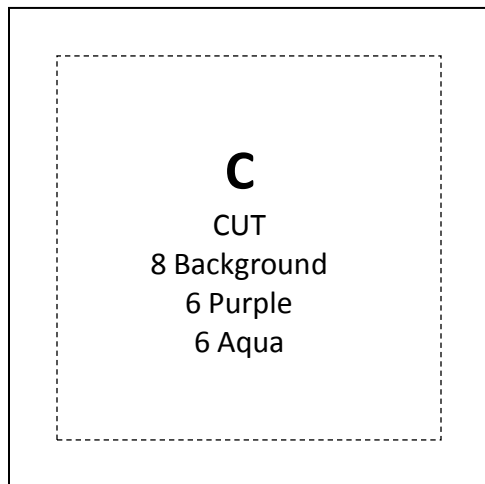


aqua / background / purple

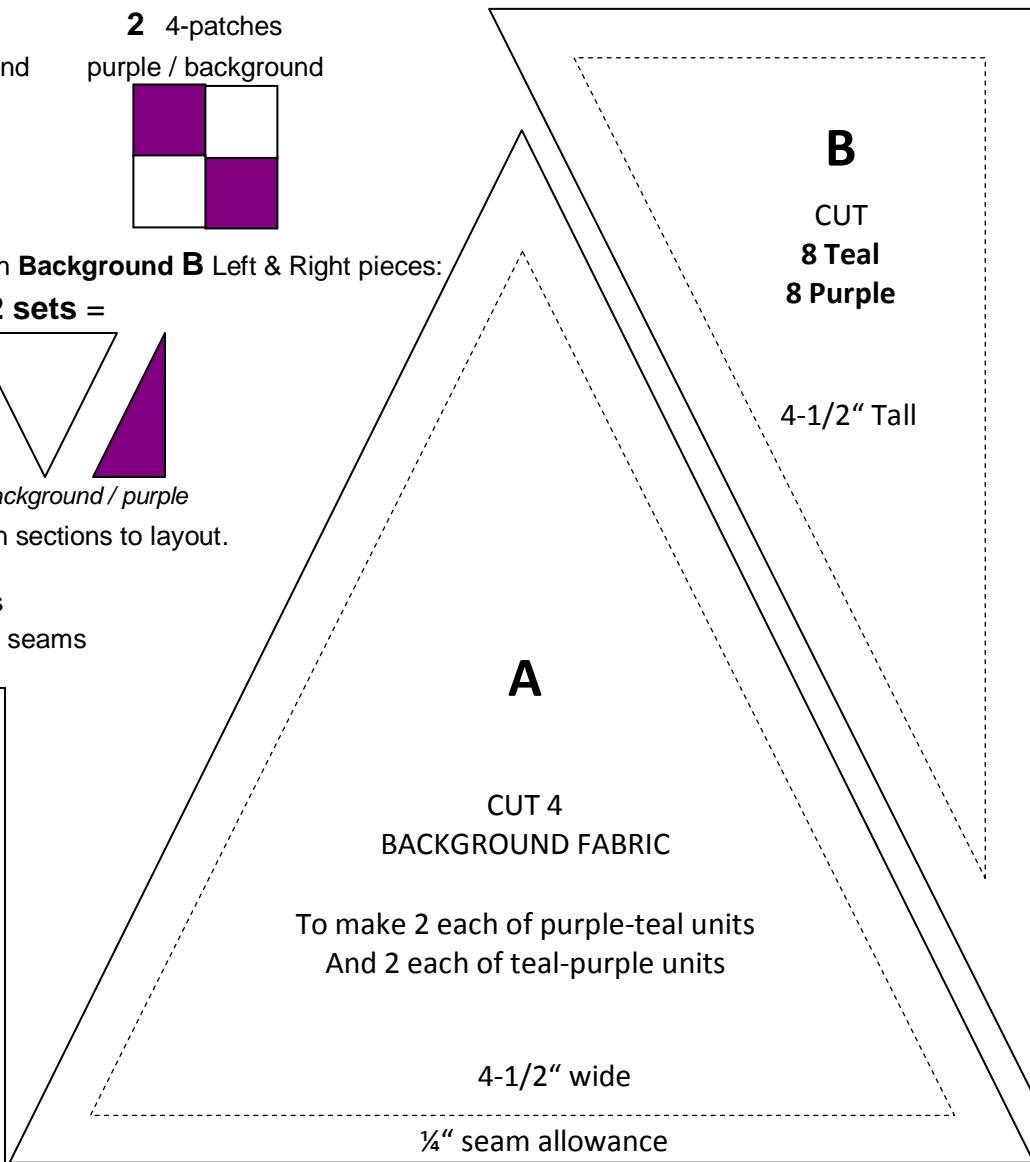
Press seams away from center, Return sections to layout.

Step 4 Trim all blocks to 4 1/2 inches

Step 5 Sew Blocks together. Press seams
