Use Fabrics:

	Natural	8 1/4" X 16 1/2"	
	Christmas Print	8 1/4" X 8 1/4"	
	Red	4 1/4" X 8 1/4"	
	Green	4 1/4" X 8 1/4"	



Directions: (all seam allowances are 1/4")

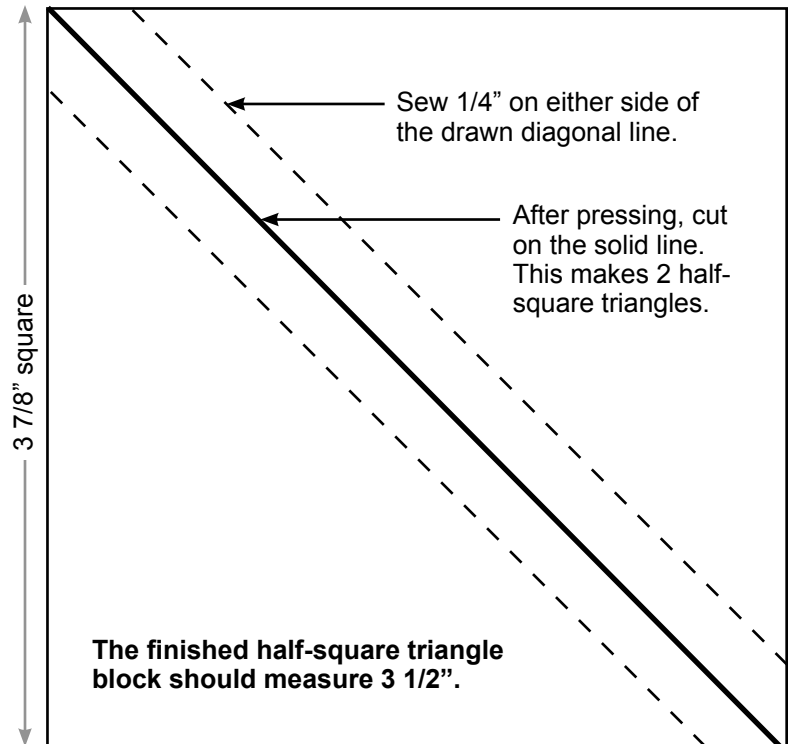
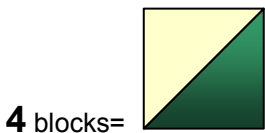
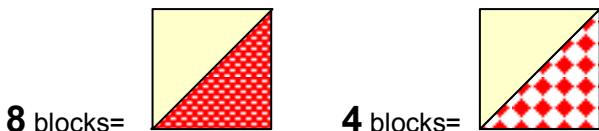
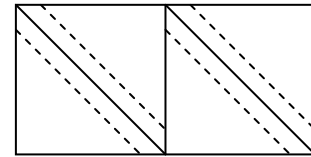
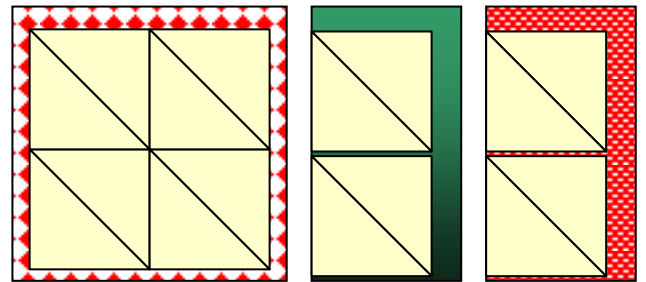
Step 1 On wrong side of natural fabric, Use pencil to draw 8 equal squares each measuring 3 7/8". Draw one diagonal line across each square corner to corner

Step 2

Place **Christmas Print** with 4-square set. (*right sides together*)
Place **Red** with 2-square set (*right sides together*)
Place **Green** with 2-square set (*right sides together*)
Sew a scant 1/4" seam on either side of all diagonal lines.

Step 3 Press to set seams.

Cut to make 3 7/8" units then cut middle diagonal lines of each to make two half-square triangles per unit. Open each set and press seam to dark side.



Step 4 Trim all blocks to 3 1/2". Position the 16 blocks as shown in diagram
Red side of blocks on outer corners
Green side of blocks as inner leaf
Christmas sides join to make petals

Step 5 Sew Blocks together. Press seams.
