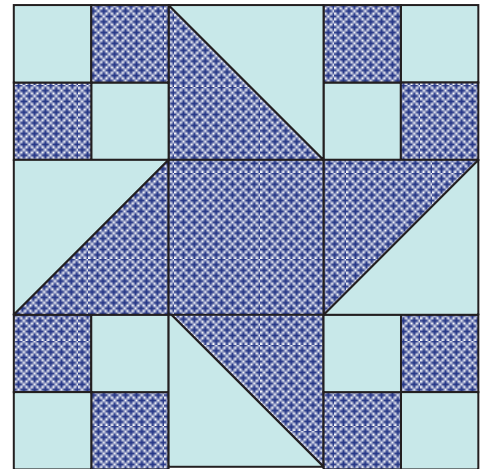

Use Fabrics:

Pale Blue	Cut 4	Triangle B
	Cut 8	Square C
Dark Blue	Cut 1	Square A
	Cut 4	Triangle B
	Cut 8	Square C

DIRECTIONS: (all seams are 1/4")

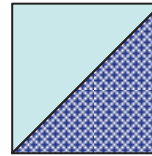
Step 1 Sew light & dark triangles together, right sides facing. Press open with seam to dark side. Trim to 4 1/2 square

Step 2 Sew 4 patches together to make 4 corner blocks. Press seams to dark side.

Step 3 Position blocks as shown in diagram. Sew together. Press seams.

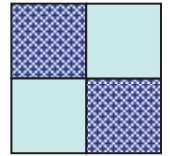
