

View Storyboard on Web site BOM page for May 2008.

**PLEASE:** Check pattern measurements for accuracy before cutting fabric.

**Fabrics:**

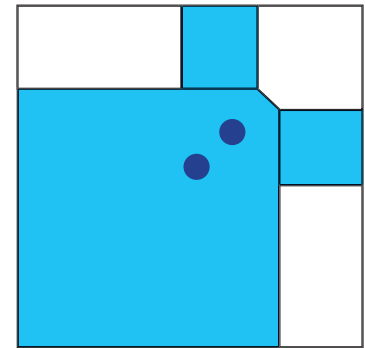
**Background:** White tone on tone or bleached muslin

**Pinafore:** Reproduction prints; you may make all 4 blocks with the same print or use different colors if you prefer.

**Buttons:** Eight small buttons 1/4" to 1/2" white or to coordinate.

**Cutting:**

- A: Four 5 1/4" x 5 1/4" squares in Reproduction fabric
- B: Eight 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" squares in Reproduction fabric
- C: Four 2 1/4" x 2 1/4" squares in Background fabric
- D: Eight 1 3/4" x 3 1/2" rectangles in Background fabric



FINISHED SIZE: 6 1/2" – make 4 blocks  
**Keep the 4 blocks separate: BOM winner will sew them together.**

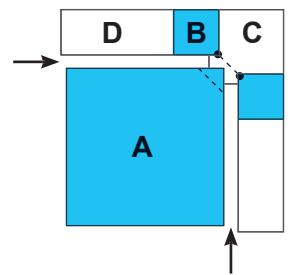
**Directions:**

1. Stitch B to D = Make 8
2. Stitch B/D units to two sides of C to form corner unit. Stitch from outer edge and stop 1/4" from inner edge, at corner dots.
3. Stitch B/D/C unit to A starting from outer edges and stopping 1/4" short, at corner dots.
4. Fold B/D/C unit corners over A. Stitch across dots to close seam. (See below.) Trim and press. Loosely attach 2 buttons to each pinafore. Each Pinafore should measure 6 1/2" square.

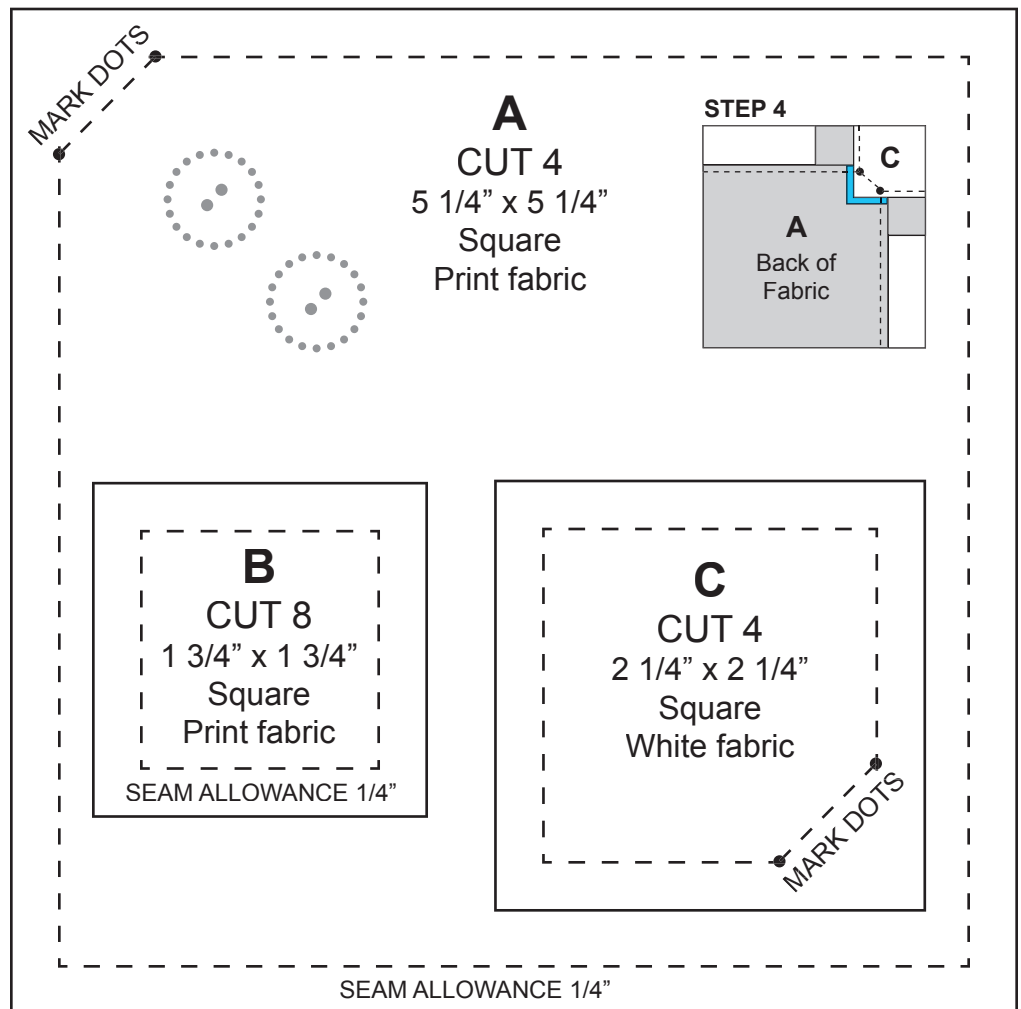
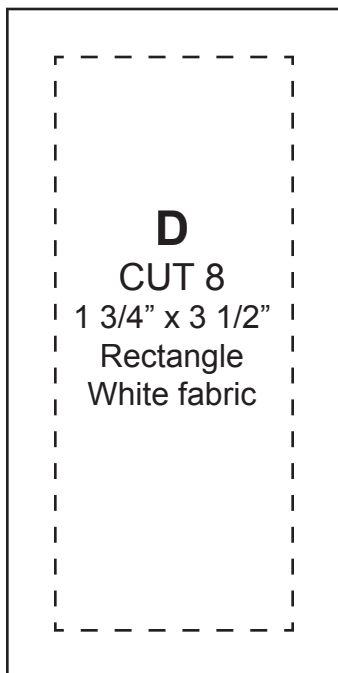
