

Please:

Check Pattern Measurements for Distance and Seams before cutting fabric



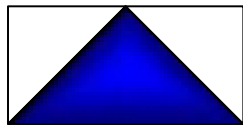
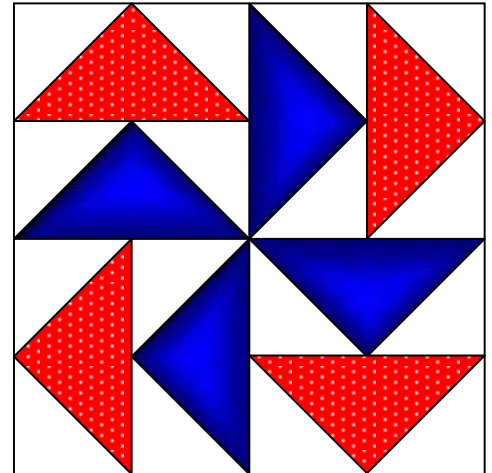
Click on **Block of the Month**, then **July 2008**

Use: Blue – Red – White fabric

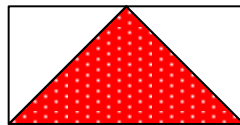
Cut: **A** = 2 Red  **A** = 2 Blue 

A = 5-3/8" Square cross cut once

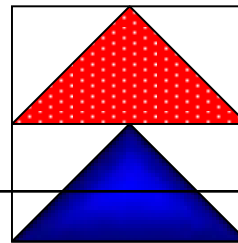
B = 8 White  3-7/8" Square cross cut once

Make: 4 each
of red/blue units

Directions: (all seams are exactly 1/4")

Step 1 With right sides together, sew long side of white triangles to short sides of blue and red large triangles. Press seams

Step 2 Sew Red and Blue sections together with a red arrow above a blue arrow. Press seams

Press seams

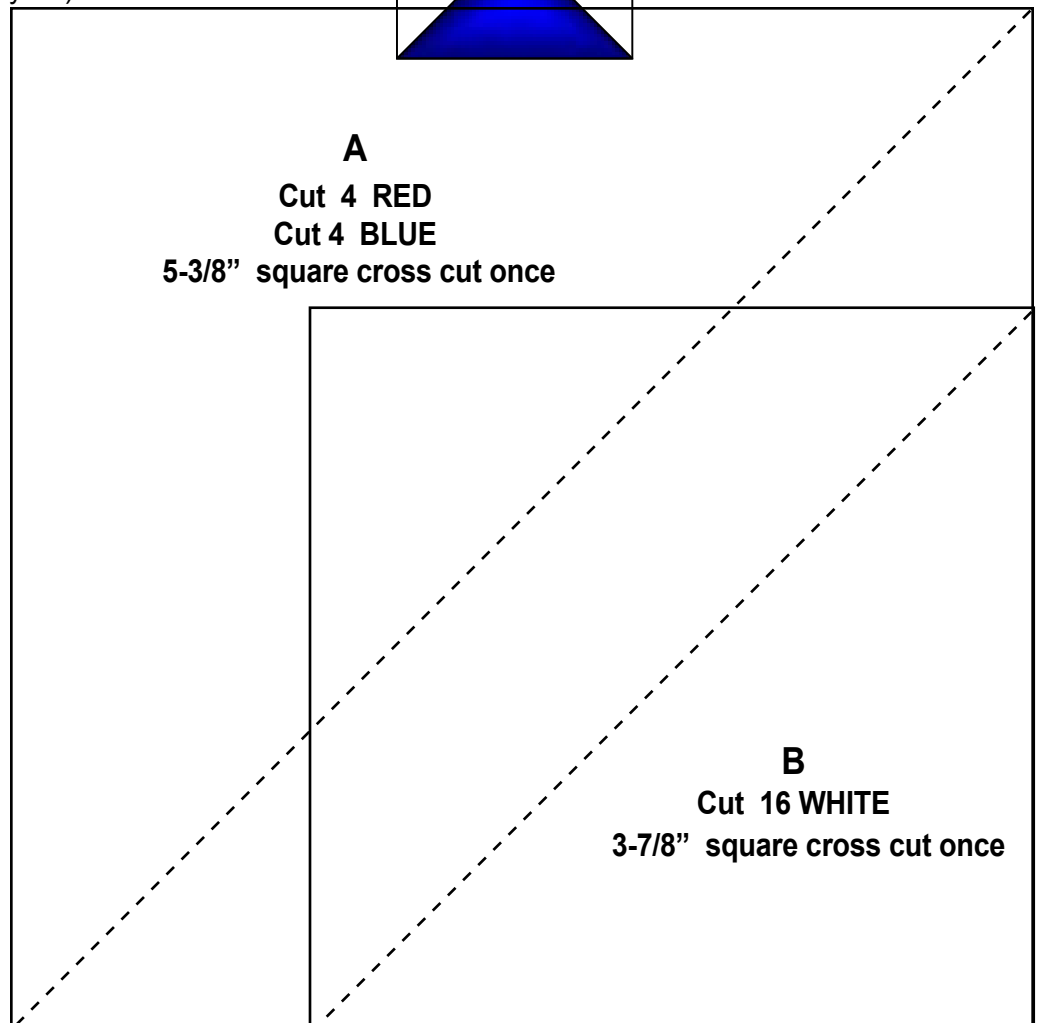
Step 3 Arrange 4 blocks as pictured above with all arrows pointing outward to the right as the block turns.

Step 4 Sew blocks together. Press seams flat

For QUICK METHOD of making Flying Geese

Find detailed instructions on the Web site BOM page.

- Using 7-3/8" Blue and Red Blocks and 4" White blocks to make 6" (finished) blocks
- Will need to make 1 blue set & 1 red set for each 12" block
- Check the storyboard on the Web site for **photo instructions**.
