

CCQ March 2009 *Block of the Month*

Paper Pieced Block with 5 layout options

Background corners are plain WHITE fabric

Kite pieces are any bright prints or solid scraps.

Step 1 Print out several copies of pattern and highlight **in color** the lines you plan to use for each kite block. One pattern for each kite.

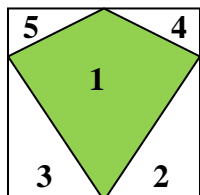
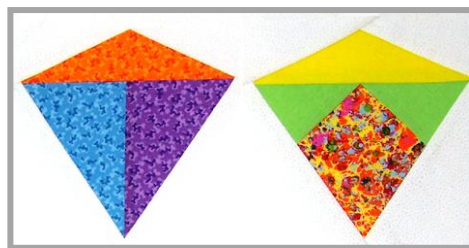
Step 2 Remember that you will be sewing the back side of the block so each fabric piece must be cut so right side of fabric will be up when finished. Allow $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance around each piece as you cut.

Step 3 Number the pieces as in selected diagram and sew in order listed.

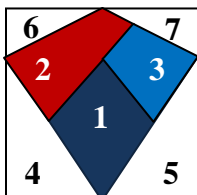
Flying Kite Block

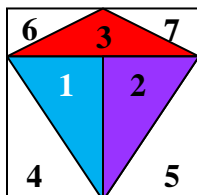

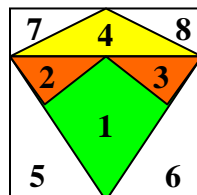

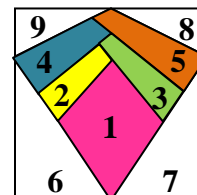
