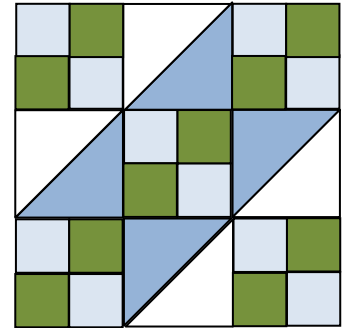

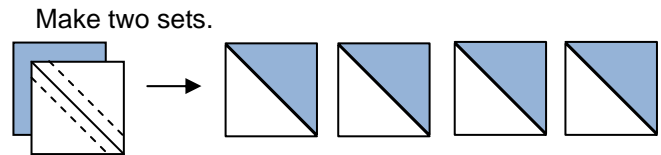

Fabrics and Cutting

	Light - A Background	Cut 2 – 4 7/8" squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square.
	Medium - B	Cut 2 – 4 7/8" squares.
	Two Contrasting Colors - C	Cut 1 – 2 1/2" x 25" rectangle (strip) from each fabric, for a total of two strips.
		

Directions: (All seams are 1/4")

Step 1 Place a light background square onto a medium square, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" from both sides of the diagonal line, cut on the line. Press toward the medium color. Repeat with the remaining squares. You will have four half square triangle units, each 4 1/2".



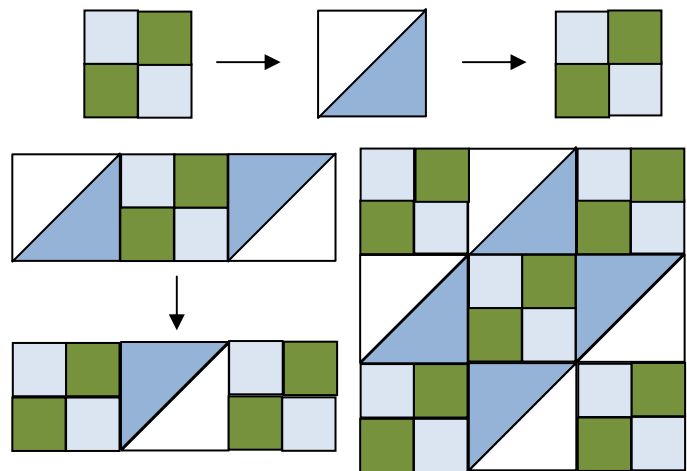
Sew 1/4" on either side of the diagonal line. Then cut them apart and press toward the darker color.

Step 2 Sew the two contrasting rectangles (strips), right sides together, along the length of the strip. Press seam toward the darker color. Cut into 10 – 2 1/2" units. Stitch these units into five 4-patch squares.



Make five 4-patch units. Each will be 4 1/2".

Step 3 Stitch together in rows as diagrammed. Press the seams in each row toward the half-square triangle units. Sew the rows together. Press the seams away from the center.
