


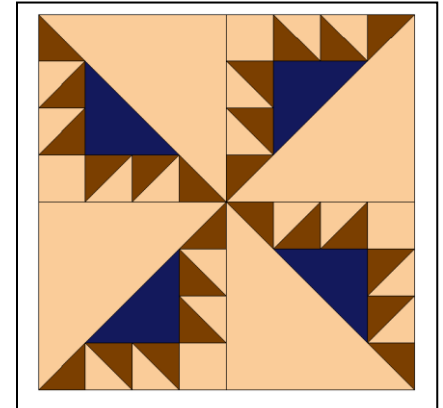

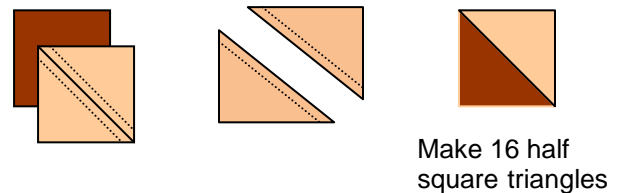
Fabrics and Cutting

-  **Light Background** Cut 2 – 6 7/8" squares. Cut each one diagonally to get 4 large triangles.
 Cut 8 – 2 3/8" squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each square.
 Cut 4 – 2" squares.
-  **Dark** Cut 2 – 3 7/8" squares. Cut each one diagonally to make four triangles.
-  **Medium** Cut 12 – 2 3/8" squares. Cut 4 of the squares diagonally to make 8 small triangles.

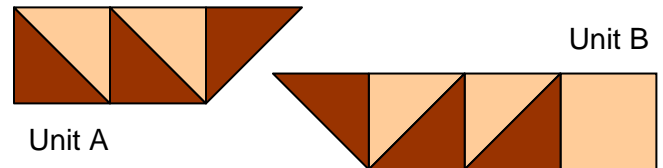


Directions: (All seams are 1/4")

Step 1 Place the 8 light background squares on the 8 medium background squares, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" from both sides of the diagonal line, cut on the line. Press toward the medium color. Repeat with the remaining squares. You will have 16 half square triangle units, each 2".



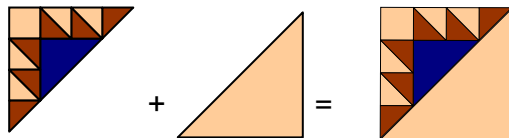
Step 2 Stitch 3 units together (Unit A), using 2 triangle units and 1 small triangle. Press toward the small triangle. Stitch 4 units together (Unit B), using 1 small triangle, 2 triangle units and 1 small background square. Press toward the square.



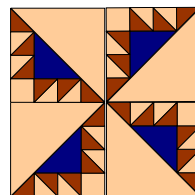
Step 3 Stitch unit A to top edge of dark triangle. Press toward the triangle. Stitch unit B to side edge of triangle and unit A. Press toward the triangle.



Step 4 Stitch large background triangle to pieced units, matching centers and pressing toward large triangle. Makes 4 units.



Step 5 Assemble into blocks.



Bring to CCQ Program meeting on June 8, 2010 or Business meeting on May 25, 2010.
