


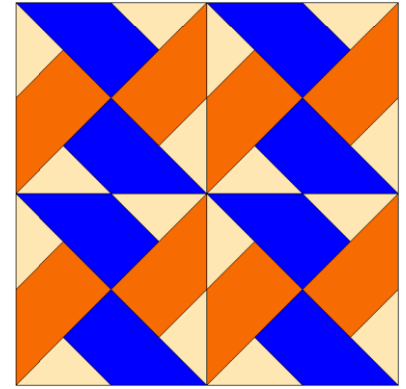

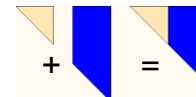
Fabrics and Cutting

-  **Light Background** Cut 4 – 4 1/4" squares. Cut each one diagonally twice to get 16 triangles.
-  **Dark** Cut 8 – 2 5/8" x 5 1/8" rectangles. To cut trapezoids, place each rectangle, right-side-up with a long side toward you, on cutting mat. Cut at a 45° angle from the bottom left corner to the upper long side. Alternate: Use template below, cutting pieces with right side of fabric up.
-  **Medium** Cut 8 – 2 5/8" x 5 1/8" rectangles. Cut into trapezoids as you did for the dark.



Directions: (All seams are 1/4")

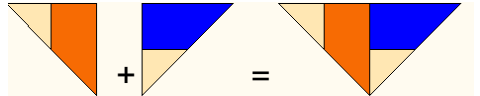
Step 1 Sew a dark trapezoid to a light background triangle. Press toward the trapezoid. Repeat to make 8 units. (The 45-degree angle on the trapezoid is a bias edge. Be careful not to stretch.)



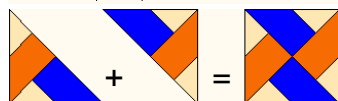
Step 2 Sew a medium trapezoid to a light background triangle. Repeat as in 1 to make 8 units.



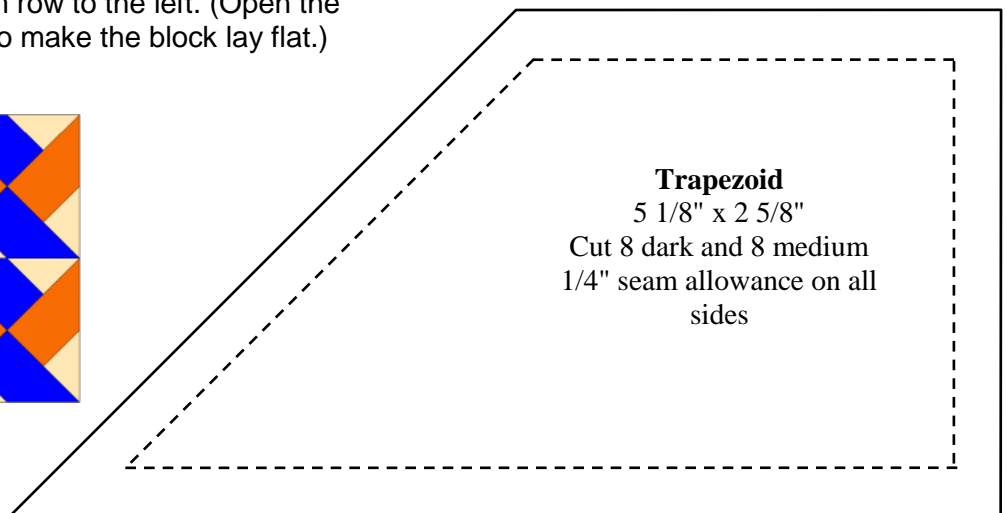
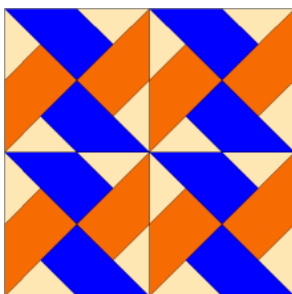
Step 3 Stitch a medium/background unit to a dark/background unit. Press toward the dark/background unit. Make 8 of these units.



Step 4 Stitch 2 of these units together. Make 4 of these units. (Remove 2 or 3 stitches in the seam intersection at the center of the back of the block to make it lay flat.)



Step 5 Sew 4 units together as shown. Press top row to the right and bottom row to the left. (Open the center back seam to make the block lay flat.)



Bring to CCQ Program meeting on July 13, 2010
