Fabrics and Cutting



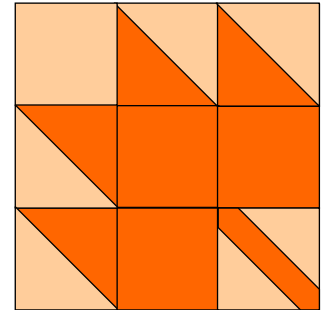
Light – A
 Background,
 cream or beige

Cut 2 – 4 7/8" squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the squares.
 Cut 2 – 4 1/2" squares.



Medium/Dark – B
 Fall leaf color:
 red, orange, gold
 tone on tone

Cut 3 – 4 1/2" squares
 Cut 2 – 4 7/8" squares
 Cut 1 – 2" by 7" rectangle

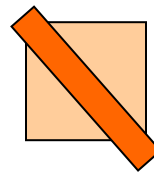


Directions: (All seams are 1/4")

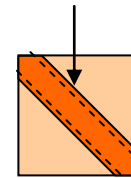
Step 1 Turn under and press a 1/4" seam allowance on the long sides of the 2" by 7" rectangle strip.

Center the strip on the diagonal of one of the 4 1/2" background squares.

Stitch to the square with a top stitch or appliqué. Trim the ends even with the square.



Top stitch or appliqué to the background.

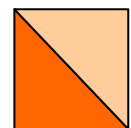
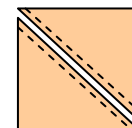
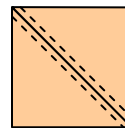


Trim the ends to match the square.

Step 2 Place one 4 7/8" background square onto one medium/dark 4 7/8" square, right sides together. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line.

Cut on the drawn line. Press toward the medium/dark.

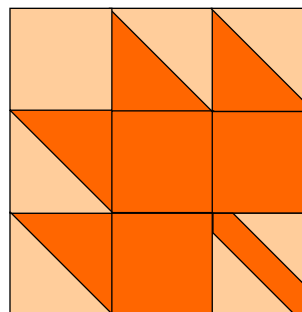
Repeat to get a total of 4 background/medium-dark half-square triangle units.



Make a total of 4 half-square triangles

Step 3 Arrange half-square pieced and plain squares together as diagrammed. Sew the vertical seams together, press seams on top and bottom rows to the left and the center row to the right.

Sew the rows together.
